

PRIVACY POLICY (MusicVideosOnly)

1.1. When you provide personal data to us, either during registration, navigation, when using the Services, making inquiries, requests or simulations through the Website, the Privacy Policy shall apply, which must be previously read and accepted by the MusicVideosOnly.

1.2. MusicVideosOnly attaches particular importance to respecting the privacy of personal data processed within the framework of our business operations.

1.2.1. In this caption, you will learn about the way we use and process your personal data for the purpose of our business and the use of our website. We also present important information about cookie files and similar technologies used by us.

Personal data is collected, transmitted and stored in accordance with the generally applicable laws, and in particular Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) – hereinafter referred to as the Regulation.

Information clause

Pursuant to Art. 13 of the Regulation, we herewith inform that:

We have appointed a Data Protection Officer, i.e. a person whom you can contact in any matters related to the processing of your personal data.

We will process your personal data for the following purposes:

1. for the purpose of concluding and executing the Services - Art. 6.1.b) of the Regulation, providing personal data is voluntary, however, your failure to provide the same will result in the inability to conclude the agreement.
2. for the purpose of achievement of our legitimate interest - Art. 6.1.f) of the Regulation, i.e. to pursue claims, detect frauds, and for direct marketing of our own and third-party products on the basis of profiling;
3. or purposes necessary to fulfil our legal obligations, e.g. for financial and tax settlements, for the period specified in the Accounting Act and the provisions of the Tax Ordinance;

You can withdraw your consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent does not affect the processing of data that took place before the withdrawal. In order to withdraw your consent, you can send the relevant information to the email address support@MusicVideosOnly.com or send your statement to the address of the data controller.

Recipients of your personal data may be entities cooperating with us, such as using MusicVideosOnly, as well as entities processing data on our behalf (e.g. in the scope of IT

support, development services, etc.).

Your data will be processed during the term of the use of Services and the limitation of claims arising therefrom.

Additionally, personal data in the scope of services performed by the processing entities cooperating with us (among other, in the scope of IT, new technologies, communication and analytical services) may be transferred to the United States of America.

Data may be transferred to:

pursuant to Art. 45.1 of the GDPR, to countries for which a decision on an adequate level of protection has been issued by the European Commission;

pursuant to Art. 45.3 of the GDPR, to third countries for which a decision on an adequate level of protection has been issued by the European Commission;

pursuant to Art. 46.2 (c) of the GDPR, to countries for which no decision on an adequate level of protection has been issued, but an adequate level of security is provided based on the standard contractual clauses;

pursuant to Art. 49.1.b of the GDPR, to countries for which no decision on an adequate level of protection has been issued.

At any point in time, you have the right to request further information about the transfer of data to third countries and to obtain copies of relevant safeguards.

You have the right to access your data and the right to demand rectification, deletion or limitation of processing and to oppose processing of your data. You also have the right to transfer data, i.e. to receive personal data that you have provided to us in a structured, commonly used machine-readable format.

How do we collect data?

When you visit our websites or use our services, we collect personal data. The ways we collect it can be broadly categorised into the following:

Information you provide to us directly: When you visit or use some parts of our websites and/or services we might ask you to provide personal data to us. For example, we ask for your contact information when you sign up for a free trial, participate in community forums, join us on social media, take part in events, contact us with questions or request support.

Information we collect automatically: We collect some information about you automatically when you visit our websites or use our services, like your IP address and device type. We also collect information when you navigate through our websites and services, including what pages you looked at and what links you clicked on. This information is useful for us as it helps us get a better understanding of how you're using our websites and services so that we can continue to provide the best experience possible (eg. by personalising the content you see). What do we use your data for?

Cookies Policy

What is a "Cookie" file?

When you use our website, we collect information about your visit and about the way you navigate the site. To do this, we use cookie files.

"Cookie" files, also referred to as "cookies", are small text files created and sent automatically by websites visited by you. The information contained in these files is saved on your computer (or another end device, such as a tablet or smartphone) and can only be used by the website from which it was sent.

What are the purposes for which the MusicVideosOnly.com. website uses "Cookies"?

We use Cookies to:

create statistics and analyses. Analytical "cookies" are used to evaluate the statistics of entering the website, as they allow us to find out what your interests and needs are, and thus to improve our website. measure the effectiveness of marketing activities conducted for our company;
match the content of advertisements to your preferences, displayed both on our websites and, for example, on Google Display Network (for more information on cookies used on the Google Display Network, please visit: <https://support.google.com/adwords/answer/2407785>);

monitoring and recording user behavior on the website; for this purpose, we use the Hotjar tool, which records data such as: navigation, page scrolling, cursor movements. Other types of information that are also being collected include; location, device used, operating system, browser and cookies.

Keep in mind that after using this function you will clear cookies in your browser and return to our Services, monitoring Hotjar will restart. remember whether you have given us consent to display certain content in the future; adapt our website to devices and browsers.

What kind of "cookies" do we use?

We use two types of cookies - session and permanent. The first ones are temporary cookies and remain on your device until you leave the website or close your browser. "Cookies" remain on your device for a specified period of time or until you manually delete them (how long a cookie will remain on your device depends on the "lifetime" of the cookie and the settings of your web browser).

How can I resign from accepting "cookies"?

Most of the browsers used, both on computers and smartphones, accept "cookies" by default. You can change it at any time in your browser's settings. However, please be advised that the inability to save/read cookies by our website may result in an incorrect display of the site in the browser.

Additionally, we also use other technologies similar to cookies, such as web beacons called pixels. These are small graphic files downloaded by your computer or mobile device after opening a given website on the Services, via advertising, e-mails or a mobile application. We use them to memorize your preferences, as well as for marketing purposes.

Some cookies are created by entities whose services we use. We use cookies for the purposes specified in parentheses : , Google Inc. (Google Analytics, Double Click and Google Adwords), Facebook, Adform (traffic analysis and ad effectiveness).

Safety

General rules for the safe use of the internet

You should have an antivirus software and firewall installed and running on your computer, tablet or phone (hereinafter referred to as the device);

Remember to have only legitimate software installed on your device;

Never log in to websites where you provide your data or confidential information using unsecured Wi-Fi networks;

Do not install unknown programs received via email or downloaded from suspicious websites;

Never reply to emails in which senders ask you to disclose confidential information;

Do not save confidential data anywhere, especially in the files on your computer.
